2.0 BIDDING PROCEDURE

Bidding will be conducted through Open Domestic Tendering. Single Stage Two Bid system is adopted for this tender. The submission and opening of bids will be through e-tendering mode at <https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app>. Tender document can be downloaded from the website <https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app> or from e-tender link given on official MNGL website www.mngl.in.

Note: To participate in the e-tendering, it is mandatory for the bidders to have user ID & password. For this purpose, the bidder has to register itself on CPPP's website <https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app>. Please also note that the bidder has to obtain digital signature token for applying in the tender and in general, activation of registration may take 24 hours subject to the submission of all requisite documents required in the process.


Note: MNGL in no way shall be responsible if the bidder fails to apply due to non-possession of Digital Signature & non registration.

3.0 DOWNLOADING OF TENDER DOCUMENT

The tender document is available for downloading from CPPP's e-tendering website <https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app> or from e-tender link given on official MNGL website www.mngl.in for viewing / participation of the eligible bidders. Bidders meeting the bid evaluation criteria who intend to submit their bid may download the tender for submission by the bid due date and time. Bidder shall give an undertaking on his letter-head that the contents of the bidding document have not been altered or modified. Bid evaluation criteria shall be applicable for all the bidders.

Disclaimer clause: Bidders are advised to visit CPPP's e-tendering website and MNGL website regularly for any updates on the tender. The ignorance to visit the website will not

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be accepted as a reason for any gap / missing information like corrigenda, amendments, clarifications etc.

4.0 PRE-BID MEETING:

The bidder(s) or their designated representatives, who have downloaded the bid document, or to whom tender document has been issued and intend to bid are invited to attend the pre-bid meeting. Bidder(s) queries if any, must reach Purchaser office at least one day prior to pre-bid meeting date. The pre bid meeting can be organized through video conferencing or physically. In case of physical meeting, the venue of pre bid meeting is MNGL office at Pride Purple Coronet, 2nd Floor, Baner Road, Baner, Pune – 411045.

Non-attendance of the pre-bid meeting will not be a cause for disqualification of a bidder. Corrigendum / addendum, if any, to the tender document, shall be hosted on the website subsequent to the pre-bid meeting.

Bidders may also note that the registration process for new bidders on e-tender portal shall take a minimum of 24 hrs. Hence, bidders are advised to kindly complete their registration on e-tender portal well in advance of the pre-bid meeting.

In case of pre-bid meeting through video conferencing, Link shall be sent to all the interested bidders by the purchaser.

Instructions to bidders for Pre-bid meeting through video conferencing: All bidders intending to attend pre-bid meeting must send their interest through email (at least 2 hours prior to the scheduled time of pre-bid meeting) to the purchaser. E-mail received from bidders within specified timeline shall be invited through email to attend the meeting.

Advisories for the bidders attending the pre-bid meeting:

(1) All the Bidders who have submitted their registration details and interest to attend the pre-bid meeting will be invited to join as guests through the link shared in mail.

(2) All bidders/participants mandatorily have to pin MNGL screen on their computer screens during the pre-bid meeting.


(3) Bidders shall be allowed to discuss their queries in sequence of their responses received.

(4) Time slot shall be allotted to each bidder to ask his queries.

(5) Recording of the pre-bid meeting by the bidders is strictly prohibited. Subsequent to pre-bid meeting, corrigendum shall be issued by the purchaser regarding clarifications or queries raised during meeting.

1.0 BRIEF PROJECT DETAILS

Maharashtra Natural Gas Limited (MNGL) is a joint venture company of M/s GAIL (India) Limited and M/s Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited (BPCL). MNGL has been set up to supply natural gas to domestic, commercial and industrial sectors including setting up of CNG filling stations to cater to the automobile sector for vehicle in Pune, Nashik, Ramanagara, Sindhudurg, Nanded & Nizamabad Geographical Areas.

2.0 SCOPE OF WORK

This tender deals with **Availing services for carrying out Pipeline Network Analysis / Capacity Determination to submit the detailed report to PNGRB.**


3.0 BIDDER'S ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

3.1 TECHNICAL:

The Bidder should have successfully executed / completed during last 5 years in single contract, to be reckoned from the final due date of submission of bid, at least one job involving submission of Capacity Determination report to PNGRB as per Schedule A and Annexure - 1 of sub-regulation 5(5) (vi) of PNGRB (Determining Capacity of City or Local Natural Gas Distribution Network) Regulations, 2015, for City Gas Distribution entity in India.

Bidders must submit documentary evidence like work order / letter of award and its completion certificate issued by client/client's consultant in support to fulfil the criteria mentioned above.


In absence of requisite documents, MNGL reserves the right to reject the bid without making any reference to the bidder.

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3.2 EVALUATION AND AWARD OF WORK:

Evaluation shall be done as per complete SOR (i.e. on total evaluated price including all taxes and duties) and order shall be placed on L-1 bidder.

In case of tie for L1 bidder, the order shall be placed on the bidder having highest turnover during the preceding 3 Financial Years i.e. 2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25.

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INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

INSTRUCTION FOR ONLINE BID SUBMISSION

The bidders are required to submit soft copies of their bids electronically on the Central Public Procurement (CPP) Portal i.e. <http://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app>, using valid Digital Signature Certificates. The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPP Portal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids online on the CPP Portal.

REGISTRATION

- (i) Bidders are required to enroll on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: <https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app>) by clicking on the link "Online Bidder Enrolment" option available on the home page. **Enrolment on the CPP Portal is free of charge.**
- (ii) During enrolment/ registration, the bidders should provide the correct / true information including valid email-id & mobile no. All the correspondence shall be made directly with the contractors / bidders through email-id provided.
- (iii) As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts.
- (iv) For e-tendering, possession of valid Digital Signature Certificate (Class II or Class III Certificates with signing key usage) is mandatory which can be obtained from SIFY /nCode/eMudra or any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India on eToken/ SmartCard.
- (v) Upon enrolment on CPP Portal for e-tendering, the bidders shall register their valid Digital Signature Certificate with their profile.
- (vi) Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSCs to others which may lead to misuse and should ensure safety of the same.
- (vii) Bidders can then log into the site through the secured login by entering their user ID/ password and the password of the DSC/ eToken.

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SEARCHING FOR TENDER DOCUMENTS


- 1) There are various search options built in the CPP Portal to facilitate bidders to search active tenders by several parameters. These parameters could include Tender ID, organization name, location, date, value, etc. There is also an option of advanced search for tenders, wherein the bidders may combine a number of search parameters such as organization name, form of contract, location, date, other keywords, etc., to search for a tender published on the CPP Portal.
- 2) Once the bidders have selected the tenders they are interested in, they may download the required documents / tender schedules. These tenders can be moved to the respective 'My Tenders' folder. This would enable the CPP Portal to intimate the bidders through SMS / e-mail in case there is any corrigendum issued to the tender document.
- 3) The bidder should make a note of the unique Tender ID assigned to each tender, in case they want to obtain any clarification / help from the Helpdesk.

PREPARATION OF BIDS:

- (i) For preparation of bid, Bidders shall search the tender from published tender list available on site and download the complete tender document and should take into account corrigendum if any published before submitting their bids.

After selecting the tender document same shall be moved to the 'My favourite' folder of bidders account from where bidder can view all the details of the tender document.


- (ii) Bidder shall go through the tender document carefully to understand the documents required to be submitted as part of the bid. Bidders shall note the number of covers in which the bid documents have to be submitted, the number of documents – including the names and content of each of the document that need to be submitted. Any deviations from these may lead to rejection of the bid.
- (iii) Any pre-bid clarifications if required, then same may be obtained online through the tender site, or through the contact details given in the tender document.
- (iv) Bidders should get ready in advance the bid documents in the required format (PDF/xls/rar/dwf/jpg formats) to be submitted as indicated in the tender document/schedule. **Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.**

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- (v) Bidders can update well in advance, the documents such as experience certificates, annual report, PAN, EPF & other details etc., under “My Space/ Other Important Document” option, which can be submitted as per tender requirements. This will facilitate the bid submission process faster by reducing upload time of bids.

SUBMISSION OF BIDS:

- (i) Bidder should log into the site well in advance for bid submission so that he/ she upload the bid in time i.e., on or before the bid submission time. Bidder will be responsible for any delay.
- (ii) Bidder should prepare the EMD as per the instructions specified in the NIT/ tender document. The details of the DD/BG/others physically sent, should tally with the details available in the scanned copy and the data entered during bid submission time. Otherwise, the uploaded bid will be rejected.
- (iii) While submitting the bids online, the bidder shall read the terms & conditions (of CPP portal) and accepts the same in order to proceed further to submit their bid.
- (iv) Bidders shall select the payment option as offline to pay the EMD and enter details of the DD/BG/others.
- (v) Bidder shall digitally sign and upload the required bid documents one by one as indicated in the tender document.
- (vi) Bidders shall note that the very act of using DSC for downloading the tender document and uploading their offers is deemed to be a confirmation that they have read all sections and pages of the tender document without any exception and have understood the complete tender document and are clear about the requirements of the tender document.
- (vii) Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document. For the file size of less than 1 MB, the transaction uploading time will be very fast.
- (viii) **If price quotes are required in XLS format, utmost care shall be taken for uploading Schedule of quantities & Prices and any change/ modification of the price schedule shall render it unfit for bidding.**

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Bidders shall download the Schedule of Quantities & Prices i.e. Schedule of Rates, in XLS format and save it without changing the name of the file. Bidder shall quote their rate in figures in the appropriate cells, thereafter save and upload the file in financial bid cover (Price bid) only.


If the template of Schedule of Quantities & Prices file is found to be modified/corrupted in the eventuality by the bidder, the bid will be rejected and further dealt as per provision of clause no 17.0 of ITB including forfeiture of EMD.

The bidders are cautioned that uploading of financial bid elsewhere i.e. other than in cover 2 will result in rejection of the tender.

- (ix) Bidders shall submit their bids through online e-tendering system to the Tender Inviting Authority (TIA) well before the bid submission end date & time (as per Server System Clock). **The TIA will not be held responsible for any sort of delay or the difficulties faced during the submission of bids online by the bidders at the eleventh hour.**
- (x) After the bid submission (i.e., after Clicking “Freeze Bid Submission” in the portal), the bidders shall **take print out of system generated acknowledgement** number and keep it as a record of evidence for online submission of bid, which will also act as an entry pass to participate in the bid opening.
- (xi) Bidders should follow the server time being displayed on bidder’s dashboard at the top of the tender site, which shall be considered valid for all actions of requesting, bid submission, bid opening etc., in the e-tender system.
- (xii) All the documents being submitted by the bidders would be encrypted using PKI (Public Key Infrastructure) encryption techniques to ensure the secrecy of the data. The data entered cannot be viewed by unauthorized persons until the time of bid opening. The confidentiality of the bids is maintained using the secured Socket Layer 128-bit encryption technology.

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A. GENERAL

1. Scope of Bid

- 1.1 The Employer, as defined in the General Conditions of Contract, hereinafter “the Employer”, wishes to receive bids for the Work as described in bidding document.
- 1.2 The successful bidder will be expected to complete the Works within the period stated in Special Conditions of Contract.
- 1.3 Throughout these bidding documents, the terms “bid” and “tender” and their derivatives (“bidder/ tenderer”, “bid tendered”, “bidding/ tendering”, etc.) are synonymous, and day means calendar day. Singular also means plural.


2. Eligible Bidders

- 2.1 Bidders shall, as part of their bid, submit duly executed power of attorney authorizing the signatory of the bid to bind the bidder.
- 2.2 This invitation for bid is open to any bidder.
- 2.3 A bidder shall not be affiliated with a firm or entity
 - (i) that has provided consulting services related-to the Works to the Employer during the preparatory stages of the Works or of the Project of which the Works form a part, or
 - (ii) that has been hired (or is proposed to be hired) by the Employer as Engineer/ Consultant for the contract.
- 2.4 The bidder shall not be under a declaration of ineligibility by Employer for corrupt or fraudulent practices as defined in ITB.
- 2.5 While evaluating the bids, pursuant to bid evaluation criteria in Global Notice of IFB, bidders and / or his sub-contractors past performance shall be assessed for ascertaining the responsiveness of the bid. In such case the decision of employer shall be final and binding on the bidder.
- 2.6 The Bidder is not put on Black / holiday list by MNGL/MoP&NG/Oil Public Sector Enterprise(s)

3. Bid Evaluation Criteria:-

3.1 Technical

3.1.1 Experience Criteria - As per Annexure – I of IFB.

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3.1.2 Equipment Deployment Criteria

The bidder shall meet the requirement regarding deployment and ownership of minimum critical construction equipment as specified in SCC Technical of the bidding document.

3.2 Financial - As per Annexure – I of IFB

3.3 Bidder shall not be affiliated with a firm or entity, (i) that has provided consulting services related to Works to Employer during preparatory stages of Works or of the Project of which the Works form a part, or (ii) that has been hired (or is proposed to be hired) by Employer as Engineer / Consultant for the contract.

3.4 Bidder shall meet the technical, as well as, commercial qualification criteria as stated above. Bidder shall furnish necessary documentary evidence such as LOA Copy/ Audited Financial along with the bid, to justify meeting the stipulated qualification criteria. In absence of requisite documents as stated above, MNGL reserve the right to reject the bid without making any reference to the bidder.

4. Bids from Consortium – Not applicable

5. One Bid per Bidder

5.1 A firm shall submit only one bid in the same bidding process. A bidder who submits or participates in more than one bid will cause all the proposals in which the bidder has participated to be disqualified.

5.2 More than one bid means bid(s) by bidder(s) having same Proprietor / Partners / Limited Liability Partner in any other bidder(s). Further, more than one bids shall also include two or more bidders having common power of attorney holder. Failure to comply this clause during tendering process will disqualify all such bidders from process of evaluation of bids.


5.3 Alternative Bids shall not be considered.

5.4 The provisions mentioned at Sl. No. 5.1 and 5.2 shall not be applicable wherein bidders are quoting for different Items / Sections / Parts / Groups / SOR items of the same tender which specifies evaluation on Items / Sections / Parts / Groups / SOR items basis.

6. Cost of Bidding

6.1 The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the bid, and MNGL will in no case, be responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

7. Site Visit

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- 7.1 The bidder is advised to visit and examine the Site of Works and its surroundings and obtain for itself on its own responsibility all information that may be necessary for preparing the bid and entering into a contract for construction of the Works. The costs of visiting the Site shall be at the bidder's own expense.
- 7.2 The bidder and any of its personnel or agents will be granted permission by the Employer to enter upon its premises and lands for the purpose of such visit, but only upon the express condition that the bidder, its personnel, and agents will release and indemnify the Employer and its personnel and agents from and against all liability in respect thereof, and will be responsible for death or personal injury, loss of or damage to property, and any other loss, damage, costs, and expenses incurred as a result of the inspection.
- 7.3 The Employer may conduct a Site visit concurrently with the pre-bid meeting.


B. BIDDING DOCUMENTS

8. Content of Bidding Document

- 8.1 The Bidding Documents/ Tender Documents should be read in conjunction with any addenda issued in accordance with ITB Clause 10.
Volume I of II
Volume II of II
- 8.2 The bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the bidding documents. The Invitation for Bids (IFB) together with all its attachments thereto, shall be considered to be read, understood and accepted by the bidders. Failure to furnish all information required by the bidding documents or submission of a bid not substantially responsive to the bidding documents in every respect will be at bidder's risk and may result in the rejection of his bid.

9. Clarification of Bidding Documents

- 9.1 A prospective bidder requiring any clarification(s) of the Bidding Documents may notify MNGL in writing or by fax or e-mail at MNGL's mailing address indicated in the Invitation for Bids not later than 7 days prior to the deadline. MNGL may, if deem appropriate, respond in writing to the request for clarification. Written copies of MNGL's response (including an explanation of the query but without identifying the source of the query) will be sent to all prospective bidders who have received the bidding documents. Any Clarification or information required by the bidder but same not received by the Employer, seven days prior to the bid due date, the same is liable to be considered as no clarification/information required.

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[In pre-bid meeting conference, all questions/ queries should be referred to MNGL on or before scheduled date of pre-bid conference. The question/ queries received by MNGL prior to pre-bid conference will be addressed in the pre-bid conference & no separate communication will be sent to bidders]


10. Amendment of Bidding Documents

- 10.1 At any time prior to the bid due date, Purchaser may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective bidder, modify the tender document, by issuing corrigendum.
- 10.2 Any addendum /corrigendum/ clarifications to bidders query thus issued shall be part of the bidding documents pursuant to ITB Clause-8.0 and shall be hosted on the MNGL's official website before bid due date. All the prospective bidders who have attended the Pre-Bid meeting till date shall be informed by email/ post about the addendum/ corrigendum/ clarifications to bidders query for their reference. Bidders desirous to submit its bid have to take into consideration of all the addendum(s)/ corrigendum (s)/ clarifications to bidders query hosted on the above websites before submitting the bid.
- 10.3 Bidders are advised to visit MNGL's websites and CPPP's e-tendering website from time to time to get updated information / documents.
- 10.4 In case of any inconsistency between an addendum and this tender document, the addendum shall prevail and in similar case between two or more addenda, the last issued addendum shall prevail.
- 10.5 The Purchaser may, at its discretion, extend the bid due date in order to allow prospective bidders, a reasonable time to furnish their most competitive bid taking into account the addenda / corrigenda issued.

C. PREPARATION OF BIDS:

11. Language of Bid

- 11.1 The bid prepared by the bidder and all-correspondence/drawings and documents relating to the bid exchanged by bidder and MNGL shall be written in English language. Any printed literature furnished by the bidder may be written in another language so long as accompanied by an ENGLISH translation duly authenticated by the chamber of commerce of Bidders country, in which case, for the purpose of interpretation of the bid, the ENGLISH translation shall govern. Metric measurement system shall be applied.

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12. Documents Comprising the Bid

12.1 The bid prepared by the bidder shall comprise the following components:

12.2 Envelope -1: Super scribing Techno-Commercial Un-priced Bids (PART-A)


12.2.1 Technical cover:

Scanned documents (duly signed by the authorized signatory) to be uploaded by the bidder on the portal as per list below:

- i) Covering Letter as per format "Submission of Tender" / "Submission of Bid" enclosed with Part- A of Vol-I of II.
- ii) Bidder's general/ details information as per format F-1.
- iii) Power of Attorney in favour of person(s) signing the bid that such person (s) is/are authorized to sign the bid on behalf of the bidder and any consequence resulting due to such signing shall be binding on the bidder.
- iv) Specific experience, annual turnover and equipment deployment details as called for in qualifying requirements.
- v) A Bid Form as per format F-2.
- vi) Copies of documents as required in list of enclosure.
- vii) Documents establishing the eligibility and conformity to the Bid Documents of all Goods and services, which the bidder proposes to supply under the award. Such

document may be, literature, drawing or data and shall also include (a) the detailed description of the Good's essential technical and performance characteristics; (b) a clause by clause commentary on Employer's technical specification and demonstrating supplies substantial responsiveness to the specifications.

- ix) Copy of Bid security in accordance with IFB & Clause 16 of ITB to be furnished either in the form of Cashier's / Banker's cheque / Bank Draft payable to MNGL at Pune/ Bank Guarantee as per format F-4.
- x) Letter of authority in favour of any one or two of bidder's executives having authority to attend the un-priced and price bid opening on specified dates and venue as per format F-5.
- xi) Confirmation of no deviation as per Format F-6.
- xii) NA
- xiii) **Indian Bidders are required to submit Employees Provident Fund registration certificate, ESIC registration certificate, Professional Tax Registration certificate, Labour welfare registration under Maharashtra Labour Welfare Fund Act and Shop Act Registration certificate.**
- xiv) Bidder's declaration that they are not under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings.

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xv) Any other information/details required as per bid document.

12.2.2 *Financial cover:*

Price bid SOR as per prescribed format on the e-tender portal.

12.3 All the documents submitted shall be duly signed and stamped on each page by the bidder or an authorized signatory of the bidder.

12.4 Bidders are advised to submit quotations based strictly on the terms and conditions and specifications contained in the bid document and not stipulate any deviations. Should it, however, become unavoidable, deviations should be stipulated only in the prescribed Pro forma. Owner reserves the right to evaluate quotations containing deviations having financial implications after adding the cost for such deviations as determined by Owner.

12.5 Original schedule of rates duly filled in shall not contain any condition whatsoever. Any condition given in this part shall not be considered and shall render the offer liable for rejection.

12.6 All signatures in bids shall be dated, as well as all pages of bids shall be initialed at lower right hand corner by the Bidder or by a person holding power of attorney authorizing him to sign on behalf of the bidder before the submission of bids.


12.7 The Bidder's bid is central to the evaluation and selection process. Therefore, it is important that the Bidder carefully prepares the bid and answers all questions completely. Missing information and vague answers may delay the evaluation of a bid and may impair the Bidder's chances of success.

12.8 Information received by Purchaser from the Bidder will be disclosed to Purchaser's employees and/or advisers or external consultants for the purpose of evaluating the bid response.


13. Bid Prices

13.1 Unless stated otherwise in the Bidding Documents, the Contract shall be for the whole works as described in Bidding Document, based on the unit rates and prices submitted by the Bidder and accepted by the EMPLOYER.

13.2 Prices must be filled in format for 'Schedule of Rates' enclosed as part of Bidding Document. If quoted in separate typed sheets and any variation in item description, unit or quantity is noticed; the bid is liable to be rejected.

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- 13.3 Bidder shall quote for all the items of Schedule of Rates after careful analysis of cost involved for the performance of the completed item considering all parts of the Bidding Document. In case any activity though specifically not covered in description of item under 'Schedule of Rates' but is required to complete the works as per Scope of Work, Scope of supply, Specifications, Standards, Drawings, General Conditions of Contract, Special Condition of Contract or any other part of Bidding Document, the prices quoted shall deemed to be inclusive of cost incurred for such activity. Items against which no rate or price is entered by the bidder will not be paid for by the Employer when executed and shall be deemed covered by the rates for other items and prices in the SOR.
- 13.4 All duties and taxes including applicable Custom duty, Works Contract tax and other levies payable by the Contractor under the Contract, or for any other cause, shall be included in the rates and prices and the total bid price submitted by the bidder.
- 13.5 Prices quoted by the bidder, shall remain firm and fixed and valid until completion of the Contract and will not be subject to variation on any account except statutory variations in Goods & Service Tax as mentioned below.
- Statutory variations in Goods & Service Tax on finished product during the contractual completion period, shall be to the Employer's account for which the Contractor will furnish documentary evidence(s) in support of their claims to MNGL. However, any increase in the rate of these taxes and duties beyond the contractual completion period shall be to Contractor's account and any decrease shall be passed on to MNGL.
- 13.6 The Bidder shall quote the prices both in figures as well as in words. There should not be any discrepancies between the price indicated in figures and the price indicated in words. In case of any discrepancy, the price indicated in words shall prevail over the price indicated in figure.
- 13.7 Alternative bids shall not be considered.
- 13.8 Conditional discount, if offered, shall not be considered for evaluation.
- 13.9 The bidder shall have to raise the Cenvatable invoice in the name of Director (Commercial), MNGL, Pune
14. **Bid Currencies – VOID**
15. **Bid Validity**
- 15.1 Bids shall be kept valid for 4 (four) month from the final bid due date.

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- 15.2 In exceptional circumstances, prior to expiry of the original bid validity period, the Employer may request that the bidders extend the period of validity for a specified additional period. The request and the responses thereto shall be made in writing or by fax / e-mail. A bidder may refuse the request without forfeiture of his bid security. A bidder agreeing to the request will not be required or permitted to modify his bid, but will be required to extend the validity of its bid security for the period of the extension and in accordance with Clause 16 in all respects.


16. Bid Security

- 16.1 Pursuant to Clause-5A, the bidder shall furnish, as part of his bid, bid security in the amount specified in the Invitation for Bids (IFB).
- 16.2 The bid security is required to protect MNGL against the risk of bidder's conduct which would warrant the security's forfeiture, pursuant to Clause-16.7
- 16.3 The bid security in Indian Rupees for bidders quoting in Indian currency shall be in the form of a Bank Draft/ Banker's Cheque/ Bank Guarantee.


MNGL shall not be liable to pay any bank charges, commission or interest on the amount of Bid Security.

In case Bid Security is in the form of a Bank Guarantee or irrevocable Letter of Credit, the same shall be from any Indian scheduled bank or a branch of an International bank situated in India and registered with Reserve bank of India as scheduled foreign bank in case of Indian bidder and from any reputed International bank or Indian scheduled bank in case of foreign bidder. Bid Security shall be valid for 2 months beyond the validity of the Bid.

- 16.4 Any bid not secured in accordance with Clause-16.1 and 16.3 may be rejected by MNGL as non-responsive.
- 16.5 Unsuccessful bidder's bid security will be discharged/ returned as promptly as possible after award of contract and signing of agreement.
- 16.6 The successful bidder's bid security will be discharged upon the bidder's accepting the award & signing the Agreement, pursuant to Clause-39 and furnishing the Contract Performance Security pursuant to Clause-40.
- 16.7 The bid security may be forfeited:
- If a bidder withdraws his bid during the period of bid validity.
 - in the case of a successful bidder, if the bidder fails:

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- i) to accept the Notification of Award/Service Order (SO) or
 - ii) to furnish Contract Performance Security in accordance with Clause-40.
 - iii) to accept arithmetical corrections,
- 16.8 Bid Security should be in favour of Maharashtra Natural Gas Limited and addressed to MNGL. In case Bid Security is in the form of Bank Guarantee or Letter of Credit, the same must indicate the Bid Document and the work for which the bidder is quoting. This is essential to have proper co-relation at a later date. The Bid Security shall be in the form provided at F-4 (Bank Guarantee).
- 16.9 **The Indian / Domestic firms registered with NSIC/MSME, under its single point registration scheme are exempted from furnishing Tender Fee & Bid Security, provided they are registered for the items / work they intend to quote and subject to their enclosing with their bid a copy of latest and current registration certificate.**
- 17. **Pre-Bid Meeting – As per Clause VI of IFB**
 - 17.1 The bidder(s) or his designated representative, who have purchased bid document, are invited to attend a pre-bid meeting which will take place as indicated in IFB
 - 17.2 The purpose of the meeting will be to clarify issues and to answer questions on any matter that may be raised at that stage.
 - 17.3 Text of the questions raised and the responses given, together with any responses prepared after the meeting, will be transmitted without delay (without identifying the sources of the question) to all purchasers of the bidding documents. Any modification of the bidding documents listed in ITB Sub-Clause 8.1 that may become necessary as a result of the pre-bid meeting shall be made by the Employer exclusively through the issue of an Addendum pursuant to Clause 10 and not through the minutes of the pre-bid meeting.
 - 17.4 Non-attendance of the pre-bid meeting will not be a cause for disqualification of a bidder.
- 18. **Format and Signing of Bid**
 - 18.1 The original of the bid shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by a person or persons duly authorized to sign on behalf of the bidder. The name and position held by each person signing, must be typed or printed below the signature. All pages of the bid except for unamended printed literature where entries or amendments have been made shall be initialed by the person or persons signing the bid.

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18.2 The bid shall contain no alterations, omissions, or additions, unless such corrections are initialed by the person or persons signing the bid.

19. Zero Deviation

19.1 Bidders shall note that if any deviation are taken to the under mentioned provisions of Bid Document by the Bidder the bid is liable to be rejection.

- i) Do not meet BEC Criteria
- ii) Bid Security
- iii) Performance Security (Contract Performance Bank Guarantee), 10% of Contract/Order value
- iv) Delivery Period
- v) Terms of Payment
- vi) Force Majeure
- vii) Resolution of Dispute/Arbitration
- viii) Termination of Contract,
- ix) Warranty and Guarantee
- x) Offer not submitted for complete scope of work
- xi) Firm prices
- xii) Prices not quoted as per Schedule of Rates formats.
- xiii) The Bidder is not put on Black / holiday list by MNGL/MoP&NG/Oil Public Sector Enterprise(s)
- xiv) Bidder is under liquidation.
- xv) Bids not conforming to technical specification/requirements.
- xvi) Any other such provisions if specifically stipulated elsewhere in the Bid Document.
- xvii) Price Reduction Schedule.

However, MNGL reserve the right to request the bidder to withdraw the deviations against above mentioned provisions of Bid Documents.

20. Mode of Payment


MNGL has initiated payments to suppliers and Contractors electronically and to facilitate the payments electronically, the bidder should submit his account details in enclosed format (F-17) to facilitate payments through e-Banking/ RTGS/NEFT mode.

21. Agent/ consultant/ Representative/ Retainer/ Associate - VOID

D. SUBMISSION OF BIDS

22.0 DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF BID

22.1 The bid must be submitted on the specified e-tendering portal as specified in IFB not later than the time and date as specified in IFB. The online e-tendering portal will not

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allow anybid or part thereof whatsoever to be submitted after the due time on the due date.

- 22.2 The Purchaser may, in exceptional circumstances and at its discretion, on giving reasonable notice by email or any written communication to all prospective bidders who have been issued the bid document to extend the deadline for the submission of bids in which case all rights and obligations of the Purchaser and bidders, previously subject to the original deadline will thereafter be subject to deadline as extended.

.23. LATE BIDS/ UNSOLICITED BIDS / BID SUBMISSION AT OTHER PLACE

Any Bid Security / EMD received by the Purchaser after the deadline for submission of bid may render the bid to be declared “Late” and such bid is liable for rejection; such EMD may be returned unopened to the bidder at the sole discretion of the Purchaser. Unsolicited bid or bids being submitted in physical form or to address to other than one specifically stipulated in the bid document will not be considered for opening / evaluation /award and will be returned to such bidders.

24. Late Bids

- 24.1 Any bid received by MNGL after the deadline for submission of bids prescribed on main body of IFB will be rejected and returned unopened to the bidder. However MNGL reserve the right to consider late bid under special conditions.


25. Modification and Withdrawal of Bids

- 25.0 The bidder may modify or withdraw its bid after the bid submission, but, before the due date of submission as per provisions provided on the e-tendering portal. After the bid due date & time however, no modifications whatsoever are allowed in the bid.
- 25.1 No bid shall be withdrawn in the interval between the deadline for submission of bids and the expiration of the period of bid validity specified by the Bidder on the Bid form. In case of request in written by the authorized signatory for withdrawal of a bid during this interval, the Bidder’s bid security shall be forfeited.

E. BID OPENING AND EVALUATION

26. Bid Opening

- 26.1 The Purchaser will open all bids on the e-tendering portal in the presence of bidder(s) representatives who choose to attend, at the time, on the date and place (as specified in IFB). The bidder(s) representatives, who are present, shall sign an attendance sheet evidencing their attendance, if so required by the Purchaser.
- 26.2 The Bidder’s names and the presence or absence of requisite Bid Security (EMD) and

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such other details as the Purchaser, at its discretion, may consider appropriate, will be announced at the opening. No bid shall be rejected at bid opening, except for bids without EMD.

26.3 Bids that are not opened and read out at bid opening shall not be considered further for evaluation, irrespective of the circumstances. Bidder's specific attention is drawn to this stipulation to enable the representative of the Bidder at the bid opening time to bring out to the attention for the Purchaser any documents pertaining to its bid is not being acknowledged and relevant portions read out.

26.4 The Purchaser will prepare a bid opening statement to be signed by all representatives present during bid opening.

27. Process to be Confidential

27.1 Information relating to the examination, clarification, evaluation and comparison of bids, and recommendations for the award of a contract, shall not be disclosed to bidders or any other persons officially concerned with such process. Any effort by a bidder to influence the Employer's processing of bids or award decisions may result in the rejection of the bidder's bid.

28. Contacting the Employer

28.1 From the time of bid opening to the time of Contract award, if any bidder wishes to contact the Employer on any matter related to the bid, it should do so in writing.


28.2 Any effort by the bidder to influence the Employer in the Employer's bid evaluation, bid comparison, or Contract award decisions may result in the rejection of the bidder's bid.

29. Examination of bids and Determination of Responsiveness

29.1 Prior to the detailed evaluation of bids, the Employer will determine whether each bid

- meets the Bid Evaluation Criteria;
- has been properly signed;
- is accompanied by the required securities;
- is substantially responsive to the requirements of the bidding documents; and
- provides any clarification and/ or substantiation that the Employer may require to determine responsiveness pursuant to Sub-Clause 29.2.

29.2 A substantially responsive bid is one which conforms to all the terms, conditions and specifications of the bidding documents without material deviations or reservations. A material deviation or reservation is one

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- a) that affects in any substantial way the scope, quality, or performance of the Works;
- b) that limits in any substantial way, inconsistent with the bidding documents, the Employer's rights or the bidder's obligations under the contract; or
- c) Whose rectification would affect unfairly the competitive position of other bidders presenting substantially responsive bids.

29.3 If a bid is not substantially responsive, it will be rejected by the Employer and may not subsequently be made responsive by correction or withdrawal of the nonconforming deviation or reservation.

OPENING OF PRICE BID

In case of two-part bidding, the Bidders whose bids are found substantially responsive shall be invited to attend the opening of price bid. Such bidders may be required to attend the price bid opening at a short notice. The place, date and time of price bid opening will be informed to all such Bidders. The Bidder's representatives who are present shall sign a register evidencing their attendance.

The bid prices stated in the price schedules will be announced during price bid opening.

30. **Correction of Errors**

30.1 Bids determined to be substantially responsive will be checked by the Employer for any arithmetic errors. Errors will be corrected by the Employer as follows:


- a) where there is a discrepancy between the amounts in words and in figures, the amount in words will govern; and
- b) where there is a discrepancy between the unit rate and the total resulting from multiplying the unit rate by the quantity, the unit rate as quoted will govern.

30.2 The amount stated in the bid will be adjusted by the Employer in accordance with the above procedure for the correction of errors and, with the concurrence of the bidder, shall be considered as binding upon the bidder. If the bidder does not accept the corrected amount of bid, its bid will be rejected, and the bid security shall be forfeited.

31. **Conversion to Single Currency for Comparison of Bids - NOT APPLICABLE**

32. **Evaluation and Comparison of Bids**

32.1 The evaluation and comparison of bids will be done as per the provisions of the bid evaluation criteria as per Annexure – I to ITB (to be separately enclosed along with bidding document against individual tenders).

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33. **Preference for Domestic Bidders - VOID**

34. **Purchase Preference - VOID**

35. **Compensation for extended stay - VOID**

F. AWARD OF CONTRACT

36. Award

36.1 Subject to Clause 29, MNGL will award the contract to the successful bidder whose bid has been determined to be substantially responsive and has been determined as the lowest, is determined to be qualified to satisfactorily perform the contract.

37. Employer's Right to Accept Any Bid and to Reject Any or all Bids

37.1 MNGL reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids, at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders or any obligations to inform the affected bidder or bidders of the ground for MNGL'S ACTION.

38. Notification of Award

38.1 Prior to the expiration of period of bid validity MNGL will notify the successful bidder in writing by fax, cable or telex to be confirmed in writing, that his bid has been accepted. The notification of award/ Fax of Intent / Service Order will constitute the formation of the Contract.


38.2 Delivery/ completion period shall be counted from the date of notification of award / Fax of Intent / Service Order.

The notification of award will constitute the formation of a Contract, until the Contract has been effected pursuant to signing of Contract as per Clause 39 of ITB.


Upon the successful bidder's furnishing of contract performance security, pursuant to Clause 40 of ITB, MNGL will promptly notify each unsuccessful bidder and will discharge his bid security, pursuant to Clause 16 of ITB.

39. Signing of Agreement

39.1 MNGL will award the Contract to the successful bidder, who, within 15 days of receipt of the same, shall sign and return the acceptance copy to MNGL.

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- 39.2 The successful bidder shall be required to execute an AGREEMENT in the proforma given in of this standard bidding document on non-judicial paper of appropriate value (the cost of stamp paper shall be borne by the Contractor), within 15 days of the receipt by him of the Notification of Acceptance of Tender. In the event of failure on the part of the successful bidder to sign the AGREEMENT within the above stipulated period, the Bid Security shall be forfeited and the acceptance of the tender shall be considered as cancelled.
40. **Contract Performance Security**

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General Conditions of Contract

Section- I. Definitions


1. DEFINITIONS OF TERMS:

In this CONTRACT (as hereinafter defined) the following words and expressions shall have the meaning here by assigned to them except where the context otherwise required.

- 1) The OWNER/COMPANY/PRINCIPAL EMPLOYER/MNGL mean MAHARASHTRA NATURAL GAS LIMITED having its Registered & Corporate office at Pride Purple Coronet and includes its successors and assigns.
- 2) The "CONTRACTOR" means the person or the persons, firm or company or Corporation whose tender has been accepted by the OWNER and includes the CONTRACTOR'S legal Representatives his successors and permitted assigns.
- 3) The "Officer-in-charge / Engineer-in-charge" shall mean the person/ persons designated from time to time by the MNGL and shall include those who are expressly authorized by him to act for and on his behalf for operation of this CONTRACT.
- 4) The "WORK" shall mean and include all items and things to be supplied/done and services activities to be performed by the CONTRACTOR in pursuant to and in accordance with CONTRACT or part thereof as the case may be and shall include all extra, additional, altered or substituted works as required for purpose of the CONTRACT.
- 5) "CONTRACT DOCUMENTS" means collectively the Tender Documents, Designs, Drawings, Specification, Schedule of Quantities and Rates, Letter of Acceptance and agreed variations if any, and such other documents constituting the tender and acceptance thereof.
- 6) The "SUBCONTRACTOR- means any person or firm or Company (other than the CONTRACTOR) to whom any part of the work has been entrusted by the CONTRACTOR, with the written consent of the Officer-in-charge, and the legal representatives, successors and permitted assigns of such person, firm or company.
- 7) The "CONTRACT" shall mean the Agreement between the OWNER and the CONTRACTOR for the execution of the works including therein all contract documents.

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- 8) The "TENDER" means the proposal along with supporting documents submitted by the CONTRACTOR for consideration by the OWNER.
 - 9) The "ALTERATION ORDER" means an order given in writing by the Officer-in-charge to effect additions to or deletions from and alteration in the works.
 - 10) The "APPOINTING AUTHORITY" for the purpose of arbitration shall be the MANAGING DIRECTOR or any other person so designated by the OWNER.
 - 11) "NOTICE IN WRITING OR WRITTEN NOTICE" shall mean a notice in written, typed or printed characters sent (unless delivered personally) or otherwise proved to have been received by the addressee by registered post to the latest known private or business address or registered office of the addressee and shall be deemed to have been received in the ordinary course of post it would have been delivered.
 - 12) "APPROVED" shall mean approved in writing including subsequent written confirmation of previous verbal approval and "APPROVAL" means approval in writing including as aforesaid.
 - 13) "FAX/LETTER OF INTENT/SERVICE ORDER" shall mean an intimation by a FAX/Letter to Tenderer(s) that the tender has been accepted in accordance with the provisions contained in the letter.
 - 14) "DAY" means a day of 24 hours from midnight to midnight irrespective of the number of hours worked in that day.
 - 15) "WORKING DAY" means any day which is not declared to be holiday or rest day by the OWNER.
 - 16) "WEEK" means a period of any consecutive seven days.
 - 17) "VALUE OF CONTRACT" shall mean the sum accepted or the sum calculated in accordance with the prices accepted in tender and/or the CONTRACT rates as payable to the CONTRACTOR for the entire execution and full completion of the work.
2. The contractor hereby confirms that he has already inspected the work site has clearly assessed the nature and extent of work and the conditions under which it will be carried out.
 3. Contractor hereby agrees to provide services and necessary supervision to carry out the work set down in the Schedule of works which forms part of this contract in accordance with the conditions of contract laid down in this part of the contract

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read in conjunction with specific instructions given in part of this contract by utilizing the materials / services if any, agreed to be given by the Company and listed in Annexure. The contractor has to provide necessary services to carry out the work. The work executed shall be to the satisfaction of MNGL, and contract rates shall include for any incidental and contingent work although not specifically mentioned in the contract but is necessary and for its completion in an efficient and workman like manner.

4. The rates agreed herein shall remain firm till the expiry of the contract and extended period. The contractor shall not be entitled to any increase or revision (except Statutory) or any other right or claim whatsoever by way of representation, explanation or statement or elect to have been given away by any employee representation or any undertaking or promise given or elect to have been given by any employee of the company or due to contractor's own ignorance or on account of any difficulties or hardship faced by him. His rates are all inclusive. However, GST as imposed by State / Central Govt. if applicable, shall be payable by MNGL at actual subject to submission of GST regn. No.

4.1 Statutory variations


Tenderer should quote prices inclusive of Goods & service tax applicable on finished product. Any statutory variations on all taxes & duties, Goods & service tax to be included on finished product during the contractual completion period, shall be to the Employer's account for which the Contractor will furnish documentary evidence(s) in support of their claims to MNGL. However, any increase in the rate of these taxes and duties (Goods & Service Tax) beyond the contractual completion period shall be to Contractor's account and any decrease shall be passed on to MNGL.

5. All persons deployed by the contractor shall be on his pay roll and should pay wages, PF contribution and Bonus as prescribed by Govt. and the company have no liability whatsoever in this regard. The persons deployed by the contractor shall remain under his control, supervision & discipline. The CONTRACTOR shall have the power to transfer, re-deploy and terminate their services. The CONTRACTOR shall regularly make full payment of wages and salaries not less than the minimum wages, as applicable to the persons engaged by him as required by him under the law.
6. No part of the contract nor any share of interest therein shall in any manner or degree be transferred / assigned or sublet by the contractor directly or indirectly to any persons, firm or corporation whatsoever.
7. The Contractor shall be responsible for providing proper services and exercise control over persons deployed by him. He shall also be bound to prohibit and prevent his employee from taking any direct and indirect interest and/or support, assist, maintain, or help from any person or persons engaged in any anti-social activities demonstrations riots or agitation, which may in any way be detrimental

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or prejudicial to the inter- land / properties in the neighborhood. In the event of any such actions by his persons or persons, contractor shall be fully and exclusively responsible therefore and shall keep the company harmless and indemnified from any consequential claims, actions, suits, proceedings, losses, or damages on any ground whatsoever.

8. All persons of the contractor entering on work premises shall be properly and neatly dressed and wear badges/ Identity cards while working on premises of the company including work site. The contractor shall provide safety shoes, uniform as desired by MNGL.
9. In case of the company considers presence of any of the persons of the contractor undesirable for whatever reasons including integrity, conduct, competence, 24 hours notice in writing will be given by company to the contractor on receipt of the said notice, such a person will not be reemployed without express and written authorization of MNGL.
10. Any failure on part of the COMPANY at any time to enforce the strict observance of the performance of any of the terms and conditions of this CONTRACT or non-exercise of any right mentioned in the contract shall not constitute a waivers of such terms, conditions or rights and shall not affect or deprive the COMPANY to exercise the same at any later date.
11. CONTRACTOR shall from time to time during the progress of the service issue such further instructions as shall be necessary for the purpose of proper and adequate execution of the services.
12. The contractor shall remove or replace any workman whom the company considers incompetent or unsuitable.
13. MNGL reserves the right to alter the scope of work in quantum as per the urgency of work. The contractor shall accordingly provide services as may be required by contract coordinator on giving a notice of two days
14. CONTRACTOR shall exclusively be liable for non-compliance of the provisions of any acts, laws rules and regulations having execution, bearing over engagement of workers directly or indirectly for execution of work and the CONTRACTOR hereby undertakes to indemnify Maharashtra Natural Gas Limited against all actions, suits, proceedings, claims, losses, damages etc. which may be arise under Minimum Wages Act, Industrial Dispute Act, Family pension and Deposit Linked Insurance scheme or any other Act or statutes not herein specifically mentioned but having direct or indirect application for the persons engaged by the CONTRACTOR under this CONTRACT.
15. Company shall not be liable for or in respect of any damages or compensation for any injuries or for any occupational diseases to any persons engaged by the

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CONTRACTOR and the CONTRACTOR shall keep the company indemnified thereof.

16. The contractor shall be liable for making good all damages / losses arising out of theft, breakage, pilferage of any office furniture, equipment, fittings and fixtures whatsoever it may be caused directly or indirectly.
17. The CONTRACTOR/ his employees/ agents/ representatives shall not communicate or use in advertising, publicity, sales releases or in any other medium, photographs, or other reproduction of the work under this CONTRACT or descriptions of the site dimensions, quantity, quality or other information, concerning the work unless prior written permission has been obtained from the OWNER.
18. **RIGHT OF OWNER TO ACCEPT OR REJECT TENDER: -**
The right to accept the tender will rest with the OWNER. The OWNER, however, does not bind himself to accept the lowest tender, and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the tenders received without assigning any reason whatsoever. The whole work may be split up between more than one CONTRACTORS or accept in part (not entirely) if considered expedient. Quoted rates should hold good for such eventualities.

Tenders in which any of the particulars and prescribed information are missing or are incomplete in any respect and/or the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled are liable to be rejected. The Tender containing uncalled for remarks, or any additional conditions are liable to be rejected.

Canvassing in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and tenders submitted by the Tenderers who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.

19. **TENDERER'S RESPONSIBILITY: -**
The intending tenderers shall be deemed to have visited the SITE and familiarized themselves thoroughly with the site conditions before submitting the tender. Non-familiarity with the site conditions will not be considered a reason either for extra claims or for not carrying out the works in strict conformity with the DRAWINGS and SPECIFICATIONS.
20. **SIGNING OF THE CONTRACT:-**
The successful tenderer shall be required to execute an AGREEMENT in the proforma attached with Tender Document within 15 days of the receipt by him of the LETTER OF INTENT OR SERVICE ORDER whichever is earlier.
21. **NOTE TO SCHEDULE OF RATES:-**
The Schedule of Rates should be read in conjunction with all the other sections of the tender.

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The tenderer shall be deemed to have studied the details of WORK to be done within TIME SCHEDULE and to have acquainted himself of the conditions prevailing at site.

Rates must be filled in the schedule of Rates of original Tender Documents. If quoted in separate typed sheets, no variation in item description or specification shall be accepted. Any exceptions taken by the tenderer to the schedule of Rates shall be brought out in the terms and conditions of offer.

The quantities shown against the various items are only approximate. Any increase or decrease in the quantities shall not form the basis of alteration of the rates quoted and accepted.

The OWNER reserves the right to interpolate the rates for such items of work falling between similar items or lower and higher magnitude.


22. POLICY FOR TENDERS UNDER CONSIDERATION: -

Only those Tenders which are complete in all respects and are strictly in accordance with the Terms and conditions and Technical Specifications of Tender Document, shall be considered for evaluation. Such Tenders shall be deemed to be under consideration immediately after opening of Tender and until such time an official intimation of acceptance/rejection of Tender is made by MNGL to the Tenderer.

MNGL if necessary, will obtain clarifications on the Tender by requesting for such information/clarifications from any or all Tenderers either in writing or through personal contact, as may be necessary, and the Tenderers are advised to refrain from contacting by any means MNGL and/or their employee(s)/representative(s) on their own, on matters related to Tenders under consideration. Tenderers will not be permitted to change the substance of the Tenders after opening of Tenders.

23. CONTRACTOR TO INDEMNIFY THE MNGL:

The contractor shall indemnify the MNGL against all actions, proceedings claims, demands, costs and expenses which may be made against the MNGL or government for or in respect of or arising out of any failure by the contractor in the performance of his obligation under the contract document. MNGL shall not be liable for or in respect of any demands or compensation payable under any law in respect of any consequence of any accident or injury to any workmen or other person in the contractor shall indemnify and keep indemnified MNGL against all such damages and compensation & against all claims, demands proceedings, costs, charges and expenses whatsoever in respect thereof or in relation thereto.

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24. Following documents form the part of this contract.

- a. Instructions to bidders,
- b. Bid qualification criteria,
- c. General conditions of contract.
- d. Special conditions of contract and
- e. Schedule of work / rates.


In case of doubt or dispute as to the interpretation of any clause contained, the decision of the company shall be final and binding on the contractor.

25. FORCE MAJURE:


If at any time during the currency of the contract the performance in whole or part by either party, or any obligation under this contract shall be prevented or delayed by reason of any hostility, act of public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fire floods, explosions, epidemics, quarantine, strikes, lookouts or acts of God (hereinafter referred to as events) then provided notice of the happening of any such events is given by either party to the other forthwith by not exceeding four hours from time of occurrence thereof, neither party shall by reason of any such event be entitled to have claim for charges / compensation / damages against the other in respect of such non-performance and / or delay in performance during such period.

26. LABOUR LAWS:

- a) No labor below the age of 18 (eighteen) years shall be employed on the WORK.
- b) The CONTRACTOR shall not pay less than what is provided under law to laborer's engaged by him on the WORK.
- c) The CONTRACTOR shall at his expense comply with all labour laws and keep the PRINCIPAL EMPLOYER indemnified in respect thereof.
- d) The CONTRACTOR shall pay equal wages for men and women in accordance with applicable labour laws.
- e) If the CONTRACTOR is covered under the Contract labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, he shall obtain a license from licensing authority (i.e. office of the labour commissioner) by payment of necessary prescribed fee and the deposit, if any, before starting the WORK under the CONTRACT. Such fee/deposit shall be borne by the CONTRACTOR.
- f) The CONTRACTOR shall employ labour in sufficient numbers either to maintain the required rate of progress and of quality to ensure workmanship of the degree specified in the CONTRACT and to the satisfaction of the Officer-in-charge.

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- g) The CONTRACTOR shall furnish to the Officer-in-charge the distribution return of the number and description, by trades of the work people employed on the works. The CONTRACTOR shall also submit on the 4th and 19th of every month to the Officer-in-charge a true statement showing in respect of the second half of the proceeding month and the first half of the current month (1) the accidents that occurred during the said fortnight showing the circumstances under which they happened and the extent of damage and injury caused by them and (2) the number of female workers who have been allowed Maternity Benefit as provided in the Maternity Benefit Act 1961 or Rules made there under and the amount paid to them.
- h) The CONTRACTOR shall comply with the provisions of the payment of wages Act 1986, Minimum Wages Act 1948, Employers liability Act 1935, workmen's Compensation Act 1923, Industrial Disputes Act 1947, the Maternity Benefit Act 1961 and Contract Labour Regulation and Abolition Act 1970, Employment of Children Act 1938 or any modifications thereof or any other law relating thereto and rules made there under from time to time.
- i) The Officer-in-charge shall on a report having been made by an Inspecting officer as defined in Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act 1970 have the power to deduct from the money due to the CONTRACTOR any sum required or estimated to be required for making good the loss suffered by a Worker or Workers by reason of non-fulfillment of the Conditions of the Contract for the benefit of workers, non-payment of wages or of deductions made from his or their wages which are not justified by the terms of the Contract or non-observance of the said regulations.
- j) The CONTRACTOR shall indemnify the OWNER against any payments to be made under and for the observance of the provisions of the aforesaid Acts without prejudice to his right to obtain indemnity from his SUBCONTRACTOR. In the event of the CONTRACTOR committing a default or breach of any of the provisions of the aforesaid Acts as amended from time to time, of furnishing any information or submitting or filling and Form/Register/Slip under the provisions of these Acts which is materially incorrect then on the report of the inspecting Officers, the CONTRACTOR shall without prejudice to any other liability pay to the OWNER a sum not exceeding Rs.50.00 as Liquidated Damages for every default, breach or furnishing, making, submitting, filling materially incorrect statement as may be fixed by the Officer-in-charge and in the event of the CONTRACTOR'S default continuing in this respect, the Liquidated Damages may be enhanced to Rs.50.00 per day for each day of default subject to a maximum of one percent of the estimated cost of the WORKS put to tender. The Officer-in-charge shall deduct such amount from bills or Security Deposit of the CONTRACTOR and credit the same to the Welfare Fund constituted under these acts. The decision of the Officer-in-charge in this respect shall be final and binding.

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27. ARBITRATION:


Except where otherwise provided in the tender documents, all questions and disputes or difference relating to or arising under the terms and conditions or as to any other question, claim, right matter or thing, whatsoever in any way arising out of or relating to the terms and conditions of the contract or the execution of failure to execute the same whether arising during the progress of the work after the completion or abandonment thereof shall be referred to the arbitration of sole arbitrator to be appointed by Managing Director, MNGL. There should be no objection from the contractor to any such appointment on the grounds that the Arbitration is an employee of the MNGL and that he had to deal with the matter to which the contract relates and that in the course of his duties as an employee of the MNGL he had expressed vices on all or any of the matters in disputes or difference. The arbitrator to whom the matter is originally referred, being unable to act for any reason, Managing Director shall appoint another person to act as some arbitration in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract. Such persons shall be entitled to proceed with the reference from the stage at which it was left by his predecessor. It is also a term of this contract that no person other than a person appointed by the Managing Director as aforesaid should act as arbitrator and if for any reason that is not possible, the matter is not to be referred to Arbitrator at all.

28. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT / BID SECURITY

The tenderer must pay Earnest Money as given in the letter/notice inviting tenders and attach the official receipt with the tender failing which the tender is liable to be rejected and representatives of such tenderers will not be allowed to attend the tender opening, Earnest Money can be paid in Demand Drafts, or Bank Guarantee of any Nationalised / Scheduled Bank in favour of MAHARASHTRA NATURAL GAS LIMITED.

NOTE: The Bank Guarantee so furnished by the tenderer shall be in the proforma prescribed by the OWNER (as per F-4 above). No interest shall be paid by the OWNER on the Earnest Money deposited by the tenderer. - 29. Performance Bank Guarantee / Security Deposit:** The contractor shall submit Bank Guarantee in our prescribed format, for a value of **10% of total Contract** value, in favour of MNGL, valid for a period of 27 months as security deposit, from Nationalized / Scheduled bank except Co-operative bank within 15 days from the date of issue of this Service Order. The Security Deposit will not bear any interest. Any amount due to MNGL, as per contractual terms & conditions shall be deducted from Security Deposit. In case Security Deposit is not sufficient to recover the outstanding amount, then MNGL reserves the right to recover the same from any other means available to MNGL.

In case of failure to submit the Security Deposit within the stipulated time, the LOI (Letter of Intent) / Service Order issued may be withdrawn & EMD submitted against the tender may be forfeited.


30. RIGHT OF THE OWNER TO FORFEIT SECURITY DEPOSIT:

Whenever any claim against the CONTRACTOR for the payment of a sum of money arises out or under the CONTRACT, the OWNER shall be entitled to recover such sum by appropriating in part or whole the security Deposit of the CONTRACTOR. In the event of the security being insufficient or if no security has been taken from the CONTRACTOR, then the balance or the total sum recoverable, as the case may be shall be deducted from any sum then due or which at any time thereafter may become due to the CONTRACTOR. The CONTRACTOR shall pay to the OWNER on demand any balance remaining due.

- 31.** The contractor shall execute an agreement with MNGL within 15 days form the award of contract. However, agreement shall be executed only after submission of valid Security Deposit against the contract.

35. Insurance:

CONTRACTOR as far as possible shall cover insurance with Indian Insurance companies, including marine Insurance during ocean transportation.

i) EMPLOYEES STATE INSURANCE ACT (ESI):

The CONTRACTOR agrees to and does hereby accept full and exclusive liability for the compliance with all obligations imposed by the Employee State Insurance Act 1948 and the CONTRACTOR further agrees to defend, indemnify and hold OWNER harmless for any liability or penalty which may be imposed by the Central, State or Local authority by reason of any asserted violation by CONTRACTOR or of the Employees' State Insurance Act, 1948, and also from all claims, suits or proceeding that may be brought against the OWNER arising under, growing out of or by reasons of the work provided for by this CONTRACTOR whether brought by employees of the CONTRACTOR, by third parties or by Central or State Government authority or any political subdivision thereof.

The CONTRACTOR agrees to fill in with the Employee's State Insurance Corporation, the Declaration Forms, and all forms which may be required in respect of the CONTRACTOR'S or subcontractor's employees, who are employed in the WORK provided for or those covered by ESI from time to time under the Agreement. The CONTRACTOR shall deduct and secure the agreement of the to deduct the employee's contribution as per the first schedule of the Employee's State Insurance Act from wages and affix the Employees Contribution Card at wages payment intervals. The CONTRACTOR shall remit and secure the agreement of to remit to the State Bank of India. Employee's State Insurance Corporation Account, the Employee's contribution as required by the Act. The CONTRACTOR agrees to maintain all Cards and Records as required under the Act in respect of employees and payments and the CONTRACTOR shall secure the agreement of the to maintain such records. Any expenses incurred for the contribution, making contributions, or maintaining records shall be to the CONTRACTOR'S account.

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The OWNER shall retain such sum as may be necessary from the total VALUE OF CONTRACT will the CONTRACTOR shall furnish satisfactory proof that all contributions as required by the Employees State Insurance Act, 1948, have been paid. This will be pending on the CONTRACTOR when the ESI Act is extended to the place of work.

ii) EMPLOYEE'S COMPENSATION AND EMPLOYER'S LIABILITY INSURANCE:

Insurance shall be affected for all the CONTRACTOR'S employees engaged in the performance of this CONTRACT. If any of the work is sublet, the CONTRACTOR shall require providing workman's Compensation and employer's liability insurance for the latter's employees if such employees are not covered under the CONTRACTOR'S Insurance.

iii) ANY OTHER INSURANCE REQUIRED UNDER LAW OR REGULATIONS OR BY OWNER :


CONTRACTOR shall also carry and maintain any and all other insurance(s) which he may be required under any law or regulation from time to time without any extra cost to OWNER. He shall also carry and maintain any other insurance which may be required by the OWNER.

iv) ACCIDENT OR INJURY TO WORKMEN:

The OWNER shall not be liable for or in respect of any damages or compensation payable at law in respect or in consequence of any accident or injury to any workman or other person in the Employment of the CONTRACTOR or any save and except an accident or injury resulting from any act or default of the OWNER, his agents or servants and the CONTRACTOR shall indemnify and keep indemnified the OWNER against all such damages and compensation (save and except and aforesaid) and against all claims, demands, proceeding, costs, charges and expenses, whatsoever in respect or in relation thereto.

36. DAMAGE TO PROPERTY OR TO ANY PERSON OR ANY THIRD PARTY :

- i)** CONTRACTOR shall be responsible for making good to the satisfaction of the OWNER any loss or any damage to structures and properties belonging to the OWNER or being executed or procured or being procured by the OWNER or of other agencies with in the premises of all the work of the OWNER, if such loss or damage is due to fault and/or the negligence or willful acts or omission of the CONTRACTOR, his employees, agents, representatives etc.
- ii)** The CONTRACTOR shall take sufficient care that employees /representatives/agents do not cause any damage to any person or to the property of the OWNER or any third party and in the event of any


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damage resulting to the property of the OWNER or of a third party cost of such damages including eventual loss of production, operation or services in any plant or establishment as estimated by the OWNER or ascertained or demanded by the third party shall be borne by the CONTRACTOR.

- iii) The CONTRACTOR shall indemnify and keep the OWNER harmless of all claims for damage to property other than OWNER'S property arising under or by reason of this agreement, if such claims result from the fault and/or negligence or willful acts or omission of the CONTRACTOR, his employees, agents, subcontractors, his agents, representative of subcontractors.


CONTRACTOR shall exclusively be liable for group insurance as per the provision of workman compensation act for the persons engaged/employed by him. Company shall not be liable for or in respect of any damages or compensation to any persons engaged by the CONTRACTOR and the CONTRACTOR shall keep the company indemnified thereof.

37. In case the contractor fails to provide the required services under the contract to the satisfaction of MNGL, MNGL reserves the right to get the services through alternate agencies at the risk and cost of contractor and penal deduction shall be made, from the contractor's bills and the decision of MNGL in this connection shall be final and binding on the contractor.
38. The tenderer hereby agrees to provide services and necessary such provision to carry out the work as given in the scope and description of work.
39. The work executed shall be to the satisfaction of MNGL and contract rules shall include for any incidental and contingent work although not specifically mentioned in the contract but is necessary for the completion in an efficient and workman like manner.
40. The contractor (which shall include the contracting firm / company) shall be solely liable to obtain and abide by all necessary license / permissions from the concerned authorities as provided under the various labor laws / legislation including labor license from the competent authority under The Contract Labor (Regulation & Abolition) Act 1970.
41. The tenderer should have his PF account no. with Regional Provident Fund Commissioner and shall submit to the COMPANY proof of depositing the employee's contribution, on monthly basis.
42. The contractor shall also be bound to discharge obligations as provided under various statutory enactment including the Employees Provident Fund & Miscellaneous Act, 1952, The Employees State Insurance Act 1948, The

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Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act 1970, The Minimum Wages Act 1948, The Payment of Wages Act 1936, Employee's Compensation Act, 1923 and other relevant Acts rules and regulations in force from time to time in respect of the person deployed by him to carry out the obligation under the contract.

43. The contractor shall be responsible for necessary contributions towards PF, ESI or any other statutory payment to Government Agencies as applicable under the law in respect of the contract and of personnel employed by the contractor for rendering services to MNGL and shall deposit the required amounts with the concerned statutory authorities on or before due dates. Each contractor shall obtain a separate P.F. number from the concerned Regional Provident Fund Commissioner and submit necessary proof of having deposited the employees PF and shall be responsible for payment of any administration / inspection charges thereof, wherever applicable, in respect of the personnel deployed by him relating to the work of MNGL.
44. The contractor shall regularly submit all relevant records / documents in this regard to MNGL representative for verification and upon such satisfaction only, MNGL will allow payment to the Contractor.
45. The contractor shall ensure and will be solely responsible for payment of wages and other dues latest by 7th of the following month to the personnel deployed by him. The contractor shall be directly responsible and indemnify the company against all charges, claims, dues, and employment of personnel deployed by him.
46. The contractor shall indemnify the company against all losses or damages caused to it on account of acts of the personnel deployed by the contractor.
47. The tenderer shall not engage any person(s) less than eighteen years of age and shall not pay less than what is prescribed under law.
48. **MNGL RESERVES THE RIGHT TO:**
 - i. Reduce the rates at which payment shall be made if the quantity and quality of services although acceptable is not up to required standard.
 - ii. Issue the CONTRACTOR from time to time during the progress of the service such further instructions as shall be necessary for the purpose of proper and adequate execution of the service and the CONTRACTOR shall carry out and be bound by the same.
 - iii. In order the contractor to remove or replace any person engaged in providing the services to the COMPANY whom the company considers incompetent or unsuitable. Opinion of the representative in the competence of any person engaged by the contractor shall be final and binding on the contractor.


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49. AWARD OF CONTRACT: -


The Acceptance of Tender will be intimated to the successful Tenderer by MNGL either by Telegram/Fax or by Letter or like means defined as LETTER OF INTENT OR SERVICE ORDER.

MNGL will be the sole judge in the matter of award of CONTRACT and the decision of MNGL shall be final and binding.

- 50.** The contractor shall be required to obtain requisite labour license / permission from the appropriate authorities as provided under the various labour regulations, before undertaking any contract work. The contractor shall exclusively be liable for compliance of the provisions of any Act, laws, rules and regulations having execution, taking over engagement of his personnel directly or indirectly for execution of work and the contractor hereby undertakes to indemnify the company against all actions, suits, proceedings, claims, losses, damages etc. which may arise due to his noncompliance of the provisions under various laws mentioned in this document or not herein specifically mentioned but having direct or indirect application for the persons engaged under the contract. Company shall not be liable in respect of any damages or compensation for any injury or for any occupational diseases, to the employment to any person engaged by the contractor and the contractor shall keep the company indemnified thereof.
- 51.** During the currency of the job, if the work progress does not commensurate with time elapsed in respect of any person / persons engaged, the contractor shall be liable to pay the company compensation as may be considered reasonable by the company.
- 52.** In case of any default for more than three days in respect of services to be provided in accordance with the requirements specified by the officer in charge, Company will have the right to avail the services from other sources at the risk and cost of the contractor or terminate the contract and forfeit his security deposit etc.
- 53.** The company for any reason whatsoever of which the company shall be the sole judge may terminate this contract by giving notice of 30 days and the contractor shall vacate the workplace with his men and material on the expiry of such notice period in the event of such termination of the contract. The contractor shall be paid for all the work executed up to the date of terminations of the contract including refund of security deposit subject to deduction of any dues, penalties, other recoveries etc. within a period of two months at the discretion of the officer in charge.
- 54.** MNGL reserve right to short close/ Terminate the contract any time based on non-performance/ poor performance during contractual period by giving 30 days' notice.

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55. The contractor shall be liable for making good all damages / losses arising out of theft, pilferage of any furniture, equipment, fittings, fixtures, utensils, appliances whatsoever as may be caused directly or indirectly by the persons engaged by the contractor. At the appointed date, place hour the contractor shall make available persons to be engaged along with appropriate tools wherever stated.
56. The contractor shall take charge of all the materials handed over to him by the company and will be responsible for any loss/damage thereof.
57. The contractor shall issue an identity card to all its employees engaged for the services to be provided. The contractor shall also provide at his own cost safety equipment, materials, uniforms etc. to his employees. All the safety rules and regulations will be observed by the persons engaged under this contract.
58. The contract shall be directly and exclusively responsible for any liability arising due to any dispute between him and his employees and shall indemnify the company against all charges, dues, claims etc. arising out of the disputes relating to the dues and employments of personnel deployed by him.
59. The contractor shall ensure regular and effective supervision and control of the personnel deployed by him and give suitable direction for undertaking the contractual obligation.
60. For non-fulfillment of any obligation under the contract, the company reserves the right to withhold the payments due to the contractor and out of such amount or the amounts likely to fall due to the contractor (but without obligation to do so) make such payments as it may consider necessary for smooth working.
61. Contractor shall deploy the resources as per requirements.
62. The company shall have the power to issue necessary instructions to the contractor concerning discipline, decorum, work performance, safety etc. in respect of the employees of the contractor engaged by him for providing the services to the company and the contractor shall ensure compliance of all such instruction strictly.
63. No payments shall be payable other than schedules payment to the contractor.
64. The monthly quoted rates shall be inclusive of Leave wages & other statutory payments for providing such services.
65. Income tax as per rule, any other taxes shall be deducted from contractor's monthly bill / bills. Income Tax deduction certificate shall be issued to the contractors.

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66. The bidder shall deem to have quoted after having satisfied himself to the total nature of work, site of work, surrounding the means access transport availability of services & to have obtained his information on all matters which can in any way influence his offer.

1.0 GENERAL


- 1.1 The mode of measurement shall be as mentioned in relevant standard specification incorporated in the Bidding Document. Any other mode of measurements not covered in above specifications shall be followed in accordance with relevant BIS codes/ Schedule of Rates/ Specifications etc. and/ or as decided by Engineer-in-charge.
- 1.2 Payment will be made based on joint measurements taken by Contractor and certified by Engineer-in-charge. Measurement shall be based on “Approved for Construction” drawings, to be the extent that the work conforms to the drawings and details are adequate.
- 1.3 Wherever work is executed based on instructions of Engineer-in-charge or details are not adequate in the drawings, physical measurements shall be taken by Contractor in the presence of Engineer-in-charge.

F. No. Infra/PNGRB/Capdet/CGD/02/2015 In exercise of the powers conferred by section 61 of the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Act, 2006 (19 of 2006), the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board hereby makes the following regulations, namely:

1. Short title and commencement.
 - (1) These regulations may be called the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (Determining Capacity of City or Local Natural Gas Distribution Network) Regulations, 2015.
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Definitions.
 - (1) In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires,
 - (a) "Act" means the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board Act, 2006;
 - (b) "Appointed day" means the date of October 1, 2007 when the Central Government notified the establishment of the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board;
 - (c) "Authorized area" means the area as defined under the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (Authorizing Entities to Lay, Build, Operate or Expand City or Local Natural Gas Distribution Networks) Regulations, 2008.
 - (d) "Authorized entity" means an entity that is authorized to lay, build, operate or expand a city or local natural gas distribution network in a geographical area (GA) under the Act and the relevant regulations made thereunder.
 - (e) "Board" means the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board established under sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Act.
 - (f) "Capacity assessment group" means a group comprising representatives of two authorized entities other than the entity of which the CGD network capacity is to be certified and a representative of the Board as decided by the Board on case- to-case basis or any agency or entity or authorized person or any approved third party authorized by the Board for determining the capacity of the CGD network.
 - (g) "CGD network capacity" means the maximum quantity in standard cubic meters per hour (SCMH) of natural gas that can be injected into or off taken from the steel pipeline network at specific points, meeting all the technical and operational parameters fixed in steel network at steady state conditions, that is, all parameters like flow, pressure, temperature, are in harmony and vary only along the steel network but not with time or the aggregate rated capacity (in SCMH) of all City Gate Stations (CGS) connected to steel network, whichever is lower. For cases, where any entry points (CGS/DPRS/custody metering systems) are connected directly to the medium density polyethylene (MDPE) network without

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involvement of any steel network, the rated capacity of such entry points shall be considered.

- (h) “CGD declared capacity” means the capacity (in SCMH) that the steel pipeline network is capable of distributing under the steady state operating conditions determined based on the approved flow equation and the selected software package or the aggregate rated capacity (in SCMH) of all City Gate Stations connected to steel network, whichever is lower. For cases, where any entry points (CGS/DPRS/custody metering systems) are connected directly to the MDPE network without involvement of any steel network, the rated capacity of such entry points shall also be declared.
- (i) “City or local natural gas distribution network” (hereinafter referred to as CGD network) means a pipeline network as defined under clause (i) of section 2 of the Act;
- (j) “CNG Station Capacity” shall be the maximum rated capacity of running compressors at respective stations or the maximum capacity determined at the inlet flange of the compressors whichever is lower.
- (k) “consumer” means consumer as defined under clause (d), (e), (f) or (g) of sub-regulation 1 of regulation 2 of the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (Code of Practice for Quality of Service for City or Local Natural Gas Distribution Networks) Regulations, 2010.
- (l) “operator” means an entity that operates CGD network with authorization of the Board.
- (m) “Selected software package” means the software package used by the entity for determination of capacity of the CGD network.
- (n) “Steady state condition” means calculation carried out based on time-invariant pressure, temperature and flow profiles throughout a steel pipeline network using specified boundary conditions and network element set points that are entered. In other words, the steady-state run calculates the hydraulic state of a network operating at equilibrium.
- (o) “Steel pipeline network” means the steel pipeline laid and commissioned originating from the source (primarily at tap-off point from any transportation/transmission/primary network or city gate station) up to the Distribution Pressure Regulating Station or District Regulating Station (DPRS or DRS), Metering and Regulating Station (MRS) and inlet flange of CNG compressor station;
- (p) “Third party contracted capacity” means the quantity (in SCMH) of natural gas contracted with any third party for transportation through a pipeline system;
- (2) Words and expressions used and not defined in these regulations but defined in the Act or in the rules or regulations made thereunder, shall have the meanings respectively assigned to them in the Act or in the rules or regulations, as the case may be.

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3. Applicability

- (1) These regulations shall apply to an entity which is laying, building, operating or expanding or which proposes to lay, build, operate or expand a city or local natural gas distribution network.
- (2) These regulations cover the procedure, parameters both constant and variable and frequency of declaration of CGD network capacity in SCMh for CGD network.
- (3) These regulations shall not be applicable to sub-transmission pipelines, MDPE network system downstream of DPRS/DRS and service lines, including GI/copper piping of CGD network.


Note: In case, any sub-transmission pipeline has been laid by the authorized entity, the details of the same up to CGS or up to connectivity with primary network in the authorized GA shall be provided by the entity as per Annexure-3. The capacity of sub-transmission pipeline from Custody Transfer Flange downstream of connectivity from transmission pipeline up to CGS or up to connectivity with primary network in the authorized GA shall also be determined.

4. Objective.

- (1) It is intended to apply these regulations to all CGD networks for the purpose of declaration of CGD network capacity.
- (2) The capacity of the CGD network so determined shall be used for providing access to shipper on non-discriminatory basis under the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (Access Code for City or Local Natural Gas Distribution Networks) Regulations, 2011.

5. Determining capacity of a City or Local Natural Gas Distribution Network.

- (1) The determination of capacity for the CGD network shall be based on selected software package and flow equation approved by the Board under these regulations. It is not necessary for the entities to buy and install any specific software package. The entities may continue to use or operate the system based on the previously installed software but shall have to determine the capacity of the system based on the flow equation approved by the Board in any of the selected software package for the purpose of these regulations.
- (2) The entity while submitting the capacity of the CGD network to the Board, shall furnish a declaration that the capacity has been calculated using the approved flow equation. The entity shall also submit the detailed report of the capacity and indicate the software used for the purpose within ninety days of the notification of these regulations and thereafter as per the periodicity for determining capacity of CGD network defined in regulation 7.
- (3) The parameters for running the steady state simulation for determining the CGD network capacity shall be considered as given below, namely:-
 - (a) Constant parameters in the unit as specified in the approved flow equation as per sub-clause (v) of this clause.

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- (i) **Internal diameter (ID)** – The internal diameter shall be determined by deducting twice the thickness from outer diameter of steel pipes used in the CGD network. Further, the internal diameter shall be determined based on weighted average of internal diameters based on different pipe thicknesses used in different sections in the pipeline system.
- (ii) **Length** – The actual length (for already installed pipeline) or proposed length (for yet to be installed pipeline) of the pipe in the pipeline system.
- (iii) **Roughness** – This is a fixed value for a pipe which determines the unevenness inside a pipe. Depending on the pipe material, the below given value for roughness factor shall be used :


Type of Material	Roughness (micron)
Steel – New Pipe (up to ten years old)	
- With internal coating	10-15
- Without internal coating	25-45
Steel–Old Pipe (more than ten years old)	
- With internal coating	15-20
- Without internal coating	45-100

For old pipelines already operating, roughness factor shall be determined by duly calibrating actual field data in the approved flow equation. These factors shall be assessed by the capacity assessment group. For new pipelines, roughness factor used shall be decided keeping in view the operating conditions and pipeline feature like bends, valves, or any other restrictions present in the system:

Provided that the entity shall declare in advance the roughness factor considered for the pipes with relevant operating data to support the value chosen.

- (iv) **Efficiency factor** –

Steel Pipeline–Efficiency factor within the range of 0.85 to 1.0 shall be used. For old pipelines already operating, efficiency factor shall be determined by duly calibrating actual field data in the approved flow equation. These factors shall be assessed by the capacity assessment group. For new pipelines efficiency factor used shall be decided keeping in view the operating conditions and pipeline feature like bends, valves, life of pipeline or any other restrictions present in the system:

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Provided that the entity shall declare in advance the efficiency factor considered for the pipes with relevant operating data to support the value chosen giving complete analysis. The Board may direct the entity to improve upon such design.

(v) Formula – For determination of flow rate and pressure drop in the pipeline, the following flow equation shall be used:

Type of Network	Name of Flow equation
Steel Network	Colebrook White/Fundamental pipe equation with flow dependent (Colebrook White) friction factor

(vi) Velocity–The maximum allowable velocity of the gas in the steel pipeline section of CGD network shall be 30 m/s.


(vii) The steel pipeline network capacity shall be determined at maximum operating pressure (MOP) for the CGD network and with the following standard Pressure and Temperature conditions:

Standard pressure – 1.01325 bar (a).

Standard temperature+-- 15.56degree C

(b) Variable parameters-


- (i) Operating temperature – For the purpose of determining the capacity and for annual capacity declaration to the Board, the summer temperature of 30 °C shall be considered by all the entities.
- (ii) Inlet temperature – This is the actual inlet temperature (° C) of the gas from the source into the CGD network.
- (iii) Outlet temperature- This is the actual outlet temperature (° C) of the gas at the delivery point.
- (iv) Inlet pressure – The maximum pressure (in barg) that is available at the entry point to the CGD network and shall be declared by the CGD entity during capacity declaration.
- (v) Outlet pressure – The minimum pressure (in barg) that is required by the consumer at the delivery or exit point as per access arrangement entered into by the shipper and the authorized entity.
- (vi) Maximum operating pressure (MOP) –This is the highest pressure (in barg) at which a CGD Network operates during normal operating cycle and shall be declared by the CGD entity for capacity determination. However, in case an entity is operating the CGD network at certain pressure which is at variance from above for more than or equal to five years, need to submit calculation carried in line with the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (Technical Standards and Specifications including Safety Standards for City or Local Natural Gas Distribution Networks)

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Regulations, 2008 and ASME B31.8 (Latest edition) supporting the revised MOP considered in determination of CGD network capacity. For the purpose of determining MOP, the Board shall be guided by incoming pressure at city gate station or custody transfer point.


Note: In case, any sub-transmission pipeline has been laid by the CGD entity, the details of the same up to the connectivity with primary network in the authorized GA shall be provided by the entity as per Annexure-3 for the purpose of arriving at the incoming pressure at the entry of primary network in the authorized GA

- (vii) **Minimum committed pressure (MCP)** – This is the minimum pressure (in barg) at the exit points and shall be declared by the CGD entity during capacity declaration.
- (viii) **Source supply flow** – This is the maximum flow (in SCM/H) that can be available from the source (primarily a Tap-off point from any Transportation / Transmission / Sub-Transmission Pipeline or City Gate Station).
- (ix) **Delivery flow** – This is the maximum flow (in SCM/H) that is required by the consumers at the exit point as per access arrangement entered into by the shipper and the operator.
- (x) **Elevation difference** – Depending on the terrain of the ground profile, this factor will be considered from the mean sea level of the area.
- (xi) **Gas composition** – The gas composition indicating all components totaling 100% by volume is to be given with the level of impurities as per the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (Access Code for City or Local Natural Gas Distribution Networks) Regulations, 2011. From this, necessary input to the flow equation shall be worked out.
In case of more than one source, the weighted average composition of commingled natural gas beyond the second source of entry point shall be considered.
- (xii) In case of CGD network, the gas quality at exit point shall be as per the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (Access Code for City or Local Natural Gas Distribution Networks) Regulations, 2011.
- (4) All entities shall declare to the Board the constant parameters and the variable parameters for the CGD network-
 - (i) on first working day of October every year; and
 - (ii) whenever there is any addition or deletion of the supply source of natural gas.

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The entities shall also provide on first working day of October the network diagram superimposed on the authorized area map for the CGD network.

- (5) The methodology for calculation of CGD network capacity shall be as under:
 - (i) The entire steel pipeline network shall be configured in the selected software package operating offline. The steady state condition of the pipeline hydraulics with variable parameters (pressure, temperature and flow) at entry that is downstream flange of City Gate Station and declared exit points shall be simulated in the selected software package.
 - (ii) Assuming gas at the entry point (single source or multiple sources of gas) is unlimited, the selected software shall be run till inlet flange of any industrial PRS, DRS and CNG Compressor connected to the system till it reaches limiting condition of pressure required at any exit point or limiting velocity in steel pipeline network as calculated by software or maximum flow capacity is reached at exit points.
 - (iii) After satisfactory completion of simulation, add dummy load at the farthest exit points of steel network, considering the minimum committed pressure.
 - (iv) Now, simulate the steel pipeline network till inlet flange of any industrial PRS, DRS, CNG Compressor and dummy load connected to the system reaches limiting condition of pressure required or limiting velocity in pipeline as calculated by software or maximum flow capacity is reached at exit points.
 - (v) The sum of flow (in SCMH) at each exit point (i.e. Inlet flanges of Industrial PRS, DRS and CNG compressor) and dummy load in all the charge areas is the total steel network capacity.
 - (vi) The entity shall submit the details of maximum achievable steel network capacity so derived, under the steady state simulation with the details of variable and constant parameters, to the Board in the specified format at Schedule A along with the hydraulic gradient and system flow diagram for the steel network system. The entity shall submit the details of rated capacity of all entry points (CGS/DPRS/custody metering systems) including entry points, if any, connected directly to the MDPE network without any steel pipeline in between along with details of rated capacity of exit points like DRS/IPRS/CNG station etc in Annexure-1.
 - (vii) The capacity of CGD network shall be as per the operation days specified in the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board


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(Access Code for City or Local Natural Gas Distribution Networks) Regulations, 2011 for respective system.

- (viii) If the aggregate CGS capacity is less than the determined steel network capacity, then, the aggregate CGS capacity shall be considered as the steel network capacity.
- (ix) The steel network capacity so determined shall be the CGD network capacity provided that if any entry point (CGS/DPRS/custody metering systems) is connected directly to the MDPE network without involvement of any steel network, the rated capacity of such entry point shall also be considered for the purpose of capacity declaration.

6. Declaring capacity of a City or Local Natural Gas Distribution Network by the Board.

- (a) The Board, after having analyzed the report submitted by the entity regarding capacity of the CGD network with respect to the provisions of these regulations, shall decide-
 - (i) to reject the capacity so determined and direct the entity to revise the capacity calculations based on the revised parameters; or
 - (ii) to go ahead with the proposal with or without modification.
 - (b) The capacity so determined shall be declared by the Board as the capacity of the CGD network. The Board shall declare the capacity of the CGD network in the format specified at Schedule B.
 - (c) The entity, after declaring the CGD network capacity by the Board, shall publish the same in line with the provisions of the relevant Regulations on the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (Access Code for City or Local Natural Gas Distribution Networks) Regulations, 2011, on 1[its] website.
- 2 [Provided that, until the time, the Board declares the capacity of CGD Network, the entity shall publish the capacity of CGD Network as determined by it, under the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (Access Code for City or Local Gas Distribution Networks) Regulations, 2011, on its website, which shall be deemed as Board declared capacity.]
7. Periodicity for determining capacity of city or local natural gas distribution networks.
- (i) The capacity of a CGD network shall be determined on first working day of October every year or whenever there is a change

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in quantity of natural gas plus or minus 10% of previous declared capacity due to any of the following:

- (a) change in quality of gas,
- (b) modification, upgradation, addition or deletion of entry or exit points,
- (c) addition or deletion of loop lines, compressor etc.
- (ii) The entity shall submit the details of the so re-determined capacity of the pipeline to the Board in line with the provisions of these regulations for the purpose of declaration of capacity.

8. Miscellaneous.


- (1) If any dispute arises with regard to the interpretation of any of the provisions of these regulations, the decision of the Board shall be final.
- (2) The Board may, either suo moto or on a complaint, refers the issue of determination of the capacity of a CGD network, to any external consultant or expert. Cost in this

regard shall be borne by the entity or the complainant or as deemed fit by the Board on a case specific basis. However, the recommendation of the consultant or expert shall be advisory in nature to the Board and shall not be binding.

- (3) The Board may validate the computed capacity with actual capacity as per the flow regime of the pipeline with actual flow conditions as and when desired.

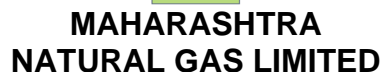

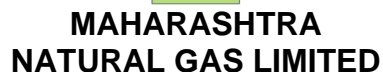
